Overall Champion Garden (FRY-HOBBS trophy) \$500

 will be considered for this award

SECTION ONE

The following gardens will be **judged over both Blackall and Tambo**, with one winner receiving \$500 (this section is deemed to be the major section of the garden competition).

<p>Flower/Cottage Garden: Planted and/or potted gardens that provide an abundance of eye-catching colour and fragrance from vibrant displays of flowering annuals and perennials. The incorporation of colour (flowers) within the entire garden will be considered when judging.</p>	
<p>Landscaped/Structural Garden: These gardens have a definite landscaped feel with inclusion of structural elements. The entire garden design will be considered for judging.</p>	
<p>Edible/Productive/Kitchen Garden: Edible gardens such as fruit, vegetable, herb, bush tucker or a combination of any. Consideration will be given to the garden's variety and selection of produce as well as the incorporation of water wise and sustainable garden practices.</p>	
<p>"Green Space": An Open Parkland style garden with the feel of an outback oasis. Incorporation of green space (lawns, shrubs, trees) that work together to create a feeling of a restful escape from the harsh outside environment.</p>

SECTION TWO

Judged over **BOTH** Blackall and Tambo with one winner receiving \$250

<p>Corporate Garden: Open to any non residential gardens from commercial businesses, schools, government premises, childcare centres, aged care facilities, sporting and community clubs/organisations.</p>	
<p>Senior's Garden: Entrants must be aged over 65 years and the entire garden will be considered for judging. Entries from both the Coolibah Village Tambo and the Barcoo Retirement Village Blackall are encouraged to enter this category.</p>	
<p>Junior Gardener's Garden: Entrants are to be 16 years and under. This section may include flower, vegetable, potted gardens and creative gardens. The garden should predominantly be the result of work by the young gardener/s themselves.</p>	
<p>Emerging/Rescued Garden: The entire garden will be considered for judging. Emerging Gardens are to be less than 5yo and Rescued Gardens are to show evidence of the previous garden that they have been developed from.</p>	
<p>Footpath/Street Appeal: Attractive footpath/front garden area with drive by "street appeal" Eligible entrants: residential, community, commercial.</p>

SECTION THREE

The following will be **judged separately** within Blackall and Tambo townships with two winners from each category. Each Winner to receive \$100

<p>My favourite garden space: a small area of the garden that has particular appeal. The area to be judged will be approximately 3m x 3m and will be an area developed and regarded by the owner as their "favourite space" - any garden area is eligible for entry in this section.</p>	
<p>Garden with the best and most creative use of recycled materials or individual garden art: These gardens have more of a casual, creative feel, with recycled materials and garden art incorporated into the overall garden. The entire garden will be considered for judging.</p>	
<p>Rose Garden: Either an entire garden or a section of the garden that is a dedicated rose garden. This category does not apply to individual rose plants situated within the garden.</p>

Garden Competition judge/s shall be under no obligation to award a category winner if they believe not enough entrants are in a section to warrant sufficient competition.
