Persons who have made a significant achievement and contribution in the field of the arts or involvement with an organization that enhances the development of the arts, culture and entertainment of the community.

Sports Award

Persons who have a noteworthy record of achievement in Sport, or have made a significant contribution to Sport as a Coach, Official or Administrator.

Junior Sports Award

Persons who have a noteworthy record of achievement in Sport, or have made a significant contribution to Sport as a Coach, Official or Administrator. **To be eligible, the person must be not more than 25 years of age on 26 January 2025.**
