TAMBO STREET ADDRESSING

Tambo town street addressing has been reviewed and maps are now available to view at the COUNCIL OFFICE in Tambo, or on Council's Web Page www.btrc.qld.gov.au



Council has used Australian Urban Addressing Standards (AS/NZS 4819:2011) to assign addresses that can be readily and unambiguously identified and located.

“The Standard will assist Emergency Services, Postal Services and the Community at large in locating your address”

Only properties that have been affected with a change in existing street numbering will be notified by letter.

All reviewed addressing will then be forwarded to Addressing Queensland addressqueensland@dnrm.qld.gov.au, which will then make all this information available to all other Government Departments. (Emergency Services, Electoral Commission etc.) Council will also notify service providers such as Telstra and Ergon, all other service providers will need to be notified by the property owner.

As from 1 May, 2016, Galvanised Posts as seen above with numbering digits will be placed by Council on all footpaths of Dwellings.
