

## WATER RESTRICTIONS

Council has introduced water conservation measures in the Blackall region.

- Sprinklers can only be used **before 10am and after 4pm** on their allocated watering days.
- Even numbered properties** can use sprinklers on **Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays**.
- Odd or unnumbered properties** can use sprinklers on **Wednesdays, Fridays and Sundays**.
- No watering on Mondays**.

## BLACKALL INDOOR SPORTS FACILITY

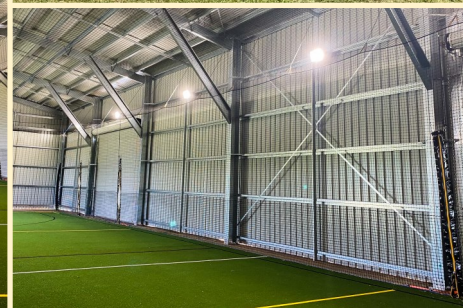
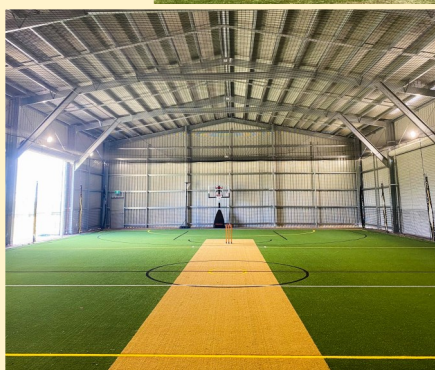
The Blackall Indoor Sports Facility is now complete and open to hire.
