SWIMMING POOLS, SPAS, AND WADING POOLS

All new swimming pools and spas require building approval from Council.

All pools and spas in Queensland must be registered with the Queensland Government, and you must have a pool safety certificate when selling or leasing a property with a pool or spa.

Inflatable wading pools are classified as a regulated swimming pool if:

- It can be filled with water to a depth of 300mm or more; or
- It holds more than 2,000 litres of water; or
- It has a filtration system.

Owners of swimming pools and spas for houses, flats and home units must comply with relevant pool fencing and pool safety legislation.
